FOCUS AREAS: Resource mobilisation, partnerships

KEY DISCUSSION POINTS:

- Co-create programmes and collaborate with donors.
- All the stakeholders (NGOs, foundations, governments and donors) need to work together.
- Each party needs to make their priorities palatable (appealing and attractive) to the other.
- Ensure effective communication. Avoid use of jargon.

CONCLUSION:

- Working together and not being siloed a key priority
- Determining where priorities overlap will be key to effective working relationships

ACTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Encourage opportunities for enhanced communication between funders and practitioners
- Consider co-creating programmes alongside key funding partners
- Work together to determine priorities and what shared values might lead to greater strength in partnerships
