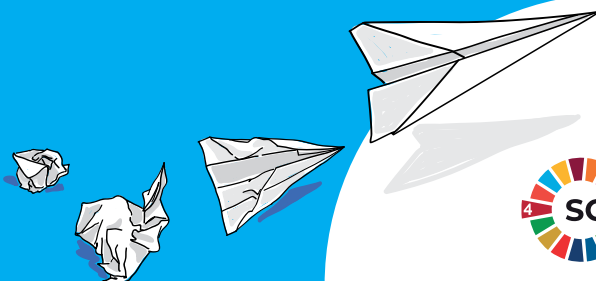

This guide is for facilitators of the Inspiring Change through Our Stories Mini Course

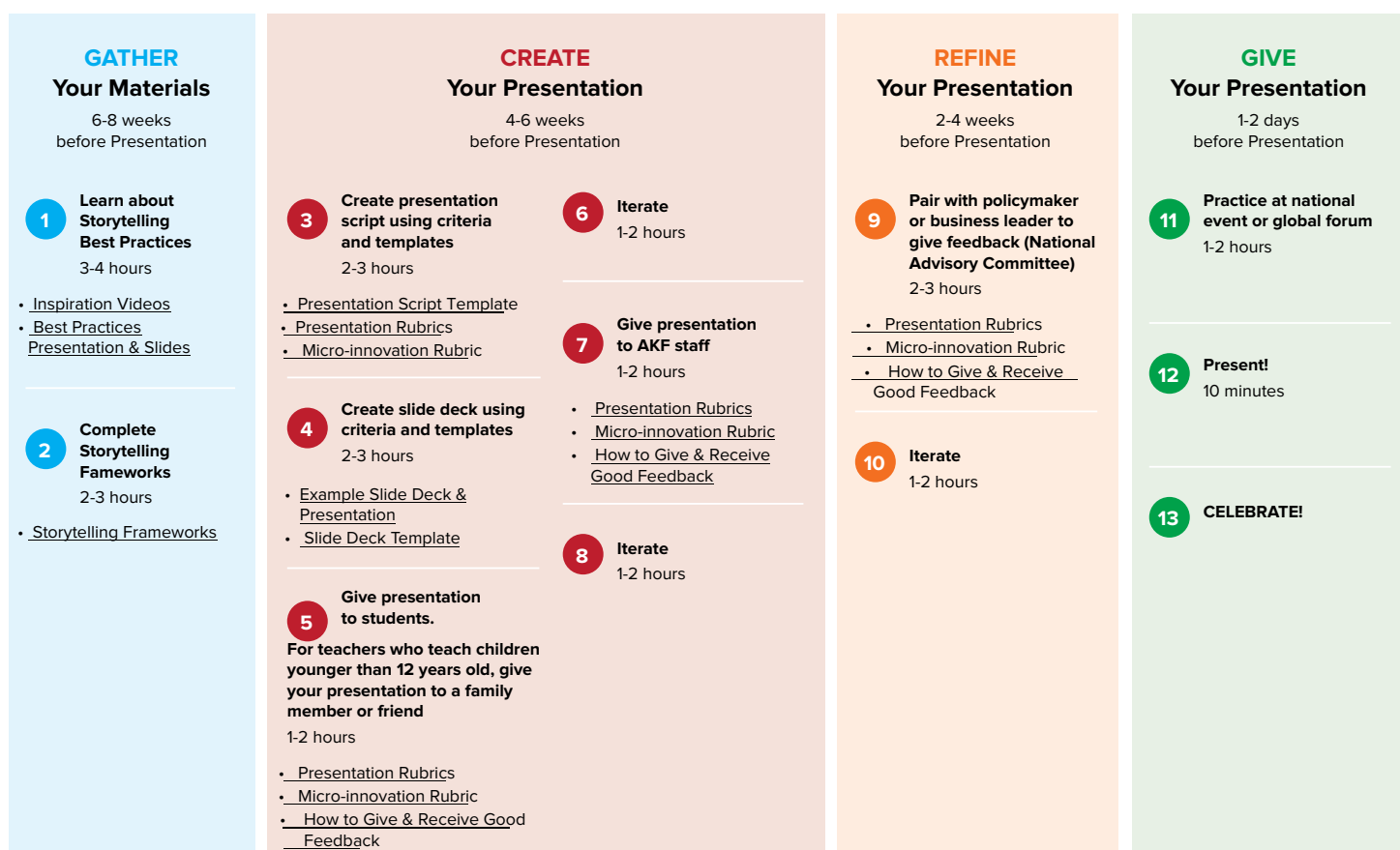
Below is an explanation of all of the resources included in the Mini Course package as well as how they work together to support educators to develop great presentations that they feel confident to share on the national and global stages.

You can use these materials to facilitate workshop sessions for educators.
You can also share these materials with teachers for a self-study course.

The structure of the Mini Course is designed around three modes: analyze great examples, create draft materials, and share, get feedback and iterate to improve and gain confidence.



LEARNING JOURNEY



GATHER Your Materials

During this phase of the Mini Course, participants will learn the essentials for how to create and deliver a compelling presentation that will influence change. Through learning best practices and reflecting on their HCD projects, participants will gather the materials they need to create their presentations.

1 Learn about Storytelling Best Practices

- Best Practice Presentation & Videos: This resource will help participants learn the best practices of creating and delivering compelling presentations.
- Inspiration Videos: These short videos are designed to inspire educators to share their stories.

2 Complete Storytelling Frameworks

- Storytelling Frameworks: These frameworks are designed to help participants reflect on their HCD projects and gather the needed materials to create their presentations.

CREATE Your Presentation

During this phase, participants will use the templates to create both the script of what they are going to say as well as the visuals they are going to use to help tell their story.

3 Create presentation script using criteria and templates

- Presentation Script Template: This slide deck has reflective questions to help the participants to develop their presentations.

4 Create slide deck using criteria and templates

- Slide Deck Template: This slide deck template is designed to help participants build the visuals for their presentations.
- Example Slide Deck & Presentation Video: This slide deck and presentation video were created by a teacher in Kenya as an inspirational example.

REFINE Your Presentation

During this phase, participants need to deliver their presentations to a variety of colleagues and AKF staff in order to get feedback. Those giving feedback should use the Microinnovation and Presentation Rubrics as criteria to evaluate the presentations. Both those giving and those receiving feedback should also reference the Guide to Giving & Receiving Feedback for best practices. Based on the feedback the participants receive, they should make improvements to their presentations. During the final practice round, participants will be paired with a policymaker or business leader to help the educator to ensure their message will be well received by other policymakers.

5 Give presentation to students & Iterate

7 Give presentation to AKF staff & Iterate

9 Pair with policymaker or business leader to give feedback (National Advisory Committee) & Iterate

- Micro-innovation Rubrics: These rubrics are designed to help the participants and those giving feedback to evaluate the participants' innovations and make improvements.
- Presentation Rubrics: These rubrics are designed to help the participants and those giving feedback to evaluate the participants' presentation in order to make improvements.
- Guide to Giving & Receiving Feedback: This guide shares best practices for those giving and receiving feedback.

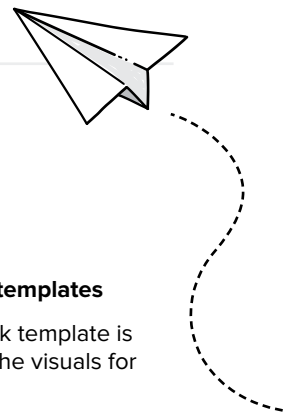
GIVE Your Presentation

The last phase of the Mini Course is giving the presentations! Be sure to support participants in the final days before the presentation. They may feel nervous or overwhelmed. Help them to prepare by listening to them practice. At this stage, be sure the feedback you give is actionable in the time remaining before the presentation. After the presentations are over, be sure to create time and space for the educators to celebrate their accomplishments!

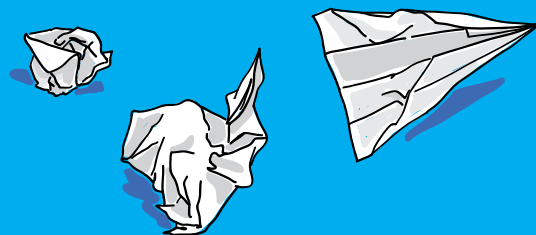
